Background

BS in Landscape Architecture from Iowa State U. and MS – Environmental Science – Utah State U. Primary employment: 4 Years Pueblo Regional Planning Commission Staff, 5 years Private Landscape Arch consultant, 34 Years USDA Forest Service Landscape Architect for Sierra, Prescott, and San Bernardino NF. Auxiliary roles with the FS Fire organization with Logistical Support unit for Type 1 & 2 Campaign Fires were Facilities Unit and Ground Support Unit Leader. Retirement from the Forest Service occurred in 2010 and from fire activity in 2018. Although, this is important experience the toll of 10 years of retirement has left me a better motorcycle mechanic than educated technician (but only 2 out of my 3 motorcycles actually run).

Cambria/ North Coast

My first visit to Cambria was a camping trip with friends in 1983. I considered it a cold miserable dump and didn't really ever want to come back. I am currently a member of PROS (Parks, Recreation, OpenSpace) Commission (Appointed by CCSD Board).
